The Chapter resolved to:

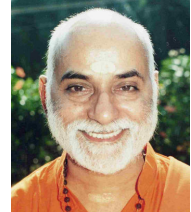
1. Conduct an outreach programme with the emphasis on reaching out to NRIs, Corporate Leaders and Educationists in the Country and abroad, to galvanize public opinion regarding the four main

thrust areas of the Foundation, viz. National Value Restoration Council (NVRC), Police Reforms, National Value Education, Electoral Reforms. This will be a part of the ongoing initiatives of the Foundation aimed at 'Influencing the Influencers'.

2. With the new Governments being formed at the States and the Centre, FRNV will engage with newly elected law-makers to persuade, inspire and facilitate their involvement in value-based Governance.
3. Expediting the implementation of Police Reforms as ordered by the Supreme Court in its judgment Prakash Singh vs. Union of India case.

FRNV PLANS

The Executive Committee Meeting of FRNV was held on 19th April 2009 in Narayanashrama Tapovanam, Trichur,

inspired and guided by the presence of Poojya Swami Bhoomananda Tirtha.

Speaking on the occasion, Poojya Swamiji said, “people are supreme in democracy. We must have a numerical strength of ‘thinking people’ and our strength is in ‘Intelligence’ and ‘Integrity’.

The following are some of the action steps FRNV Governing Body decided to initiate:

- Create a greater awareness about Value Restoration in the country.
- Establish a youth wing of FRNV so that our country’s youth plays an active role in Value Restoration.
- Work towards ‘Influencing the Influencers’. The following are some of the avenues FRNV will explore: political parties, senior corporate executives (formation of model-organizations), young politicians, specific Government departments, leaders and thinkers.
- Plan a Seminar with NRIs, Corporates and Educationists to initiate Value Restoration activities.
- Initiate formation of the Pune Regional Chapter of FRNV.

FRNV PROJECTS

NATIONAL VALUE EDUCATION

FRNV is in the process of developing a Value Education Training Programme for Teachers. This will provide inputs on how to incorporate Value Education as an integral aspect of school education in a comprehensive manner. The team has also identified schools where such training programmes can be piloted.

POLICE REFORMS

After the new Parliament is elected, FRNV proposes to establish contact with the Centre and also the Governments of a few States highlighting the importance and urgency for implementation of Police reforms. FRNV will

initiate action in the states of Delhi and Kerala.

ELECTORAL REFORMS

Letters were sent to General Secretaries/Presidents of major Political Parties urging them to pay sufficient attention to choosing the ‘right persons’ to represent their party in the elections. Appeals were also addressed to citizens to exercise their franchise and also refrain from voting for candidates with criminal background. These appeals were sent in different languages. Press also covered these significant communications (refer to the FRNV website for details).

NATIONAL VALUE RESTORATION COUNCIL (NVRC)

FRNV has deliberated upon the following areas for furthering this initiative (NVRC):

- Right to Information Act (RTI) to be used to determine lapses in different departments which can be brought to the public eye and for preventive action.
- Developing a system to track promises made by the political parties.
